# SCHOOL PORN VIDEO DRAMA

**Kids must know consequences of their actions**

**WELLINGTON - Another sixteen-year-old learner was snapped with an erect penis in her mouth on a cellphone video clip.**

According to Gert Witbooi, spokesman for the Western Cape Education Department, the department is developing guidelines for the use of cellphones in schools.

This is the latest offering in a series of home-made cellphone video clips being distributed among schoolkids in the Cape.

According to a reliable source, Len Moses, the principal of Weltevrede High School, ordered all learners on Tuesday to remove the sex clip from their cellphones immediately.

The source said: "The principal said the Grade 11 girl's face had been manipulated by computer and that she had not really committed the sex act in question.

"Her face was apparently digitally manipulated into this video.

"But this is crap, because we kids know this girl well."

According to the source the girl in the video clip is "no angel".

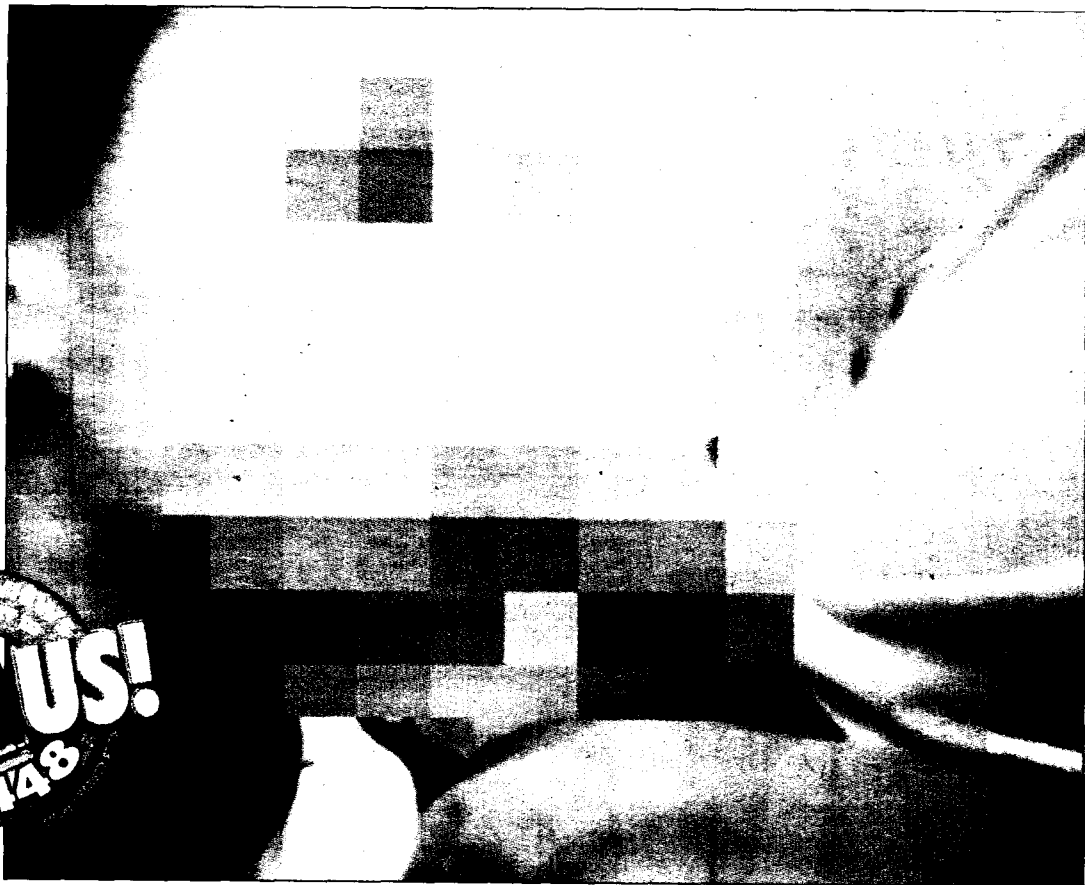
"On the photo she looks into the camera shamelessly, a penis in her mouth; without a condom.

"This scandal now has to be covered up, because her mother is a teacher here."

While the principal was making the announcement, the girl sat crying uncontrollably in her mother's classroom. The learner's name is known to *Cape Son*.

Moses denies having discussed the incident with anybody.

He said: "I heard about the clip that was doing

the rounds.

"But I haven't seen it yet and I don't want to see it, either.

"The school has a cellphone policy which we definitely apply here."

Witbooi said: "The technology in cellphones is state-of-the-art and sophisticated.

"The Education Department is currently developing guidelines in this regard.

"These guidelines will soon be sent to all schools. It will then be added to the schools' existing policy to develop it further.

"Parents give their kids expensive cellphones and the children want to explore the boundaries all the time.

"But parents and families should realise their

responsibility in this area.

"Our children need to know that pornography is illegal and criminal.

"We request principals to consult with parents regarding kids' conduct and the risks involved.

"Here I'm not referring to health risks alone. The children experiment without taking into account the consequences of their actions.

"In many cases these are children with a negative self-image who are trying their best to make a social impression on their peers.

"They don't stop to consider the impact such an act might have on their future and their career.

"Principals therefore have to remind parents and families constantly of their responsibility towards their children."
